

Supply List for 6th, 7th and 8th Grade Students 2017-2018 School Year



Supplies must be brought daily to each class. Please note that additional supplies may be added on the first day of school. Grades 6-8 students will receive an agenda on the first day of school. All textbooks need to be covered at all times. Please make sure to read **all** pages of this supply list.

Homeroom Supplies: All students bring in 2 rectangular boxes of Kleenex and 1 roll of paper towels to their homeroom.

Organizational Material: Every student **MUST** have an organizational device. It may be a traditional 3 ring binder with divider tabs, a zippered binder with divider tabs, a Velcro binder with divider tabs, or an expandable flexible folder. (No writing on them, no pictures in the slots, no glitter, etc). As responsible citizens students are required to keep all of their work during an entire trimester.

General Supplies used daily in all classes (resupply as needed):

- #2 pencils with eraser (**Always used in math science classes**)
- Pens: red, black, and dark blue (**No click-style pens**)
- 2 highlighters
- 1 set of thin felt tip markers
- 1 box (24 in all) of colored pencils
- 1 small portable pencil sharpener
- 1 6 in ruler
- 1 pair of scissors
- 1 large glue stick
- 1 container/pouch for supplies
- 3 packages of college loose-leaf binder paper (or more)
- 1 backpack
- Ear buds for use with computer
- Computer case for Acer C740
- City library card

In addition to the above general supplies, some classes require specific items. Math classes are divided after Labor Day. Science and Math classes have on-line materials making daily charged Chromebooks necessary.

Language Arts: Mead® Five Star® Wire-bound Spiral Notebook, 5-Subject, College Ruled, 8-1/2" x 11"
7th graders only need 2 composition notebooks/no spirals

Math (all levels): 2 – Graph notebooks (4 x 4 graph paper that tears out cleanly)
2- Spiral notebooks (college ruled paper that tears out cleanly)
Pocket folder or labeled section of binder for papers
Sharpened pencils at all times (all math work must be completed in pencil)
Eraser
Personal, small, silent, pencil sharpener
6-inch ruler (may use the same one as in science)

Religion: 1 *New American Bible*, St. Joseph Edition (stays in locker) - This will be supplied on the first day of school to new middle school students (must be replaced if lost).
Spiral for notes or dedicated section in binder with loose leaf paper
Pocket folder or labeled section of binder for returned papers
1 composition notebook for 6th grade
1 plastic, two pocket folder for 7th and 8th grade religion books

Robotics: 2+ pencils and eraser
1 two pocket folder with fastener
20+ sheet of paper (in folder)
1 roll of masking tape
1 ruler at least 30 cm. long, graduated in both centimeters and inches
8th grade only 3rd Trimester - a roll of duct tape and an undamaged 2 liter bottle

Science:

2 composition books, college ruled (1 for science fair & 1 for science notes in class) NO SPIRALS

Loose-leaf **lined paper**

#2 **pencils** (all science work is completed in pencil)

Highlighters: MUST have 1 yellow, 1 pink, 1 orange, 1 green, and 1 blue (used every day)

Binder Clips: To turn in science fair assignments, paperclips are NOT large enough

1 tri-fold science fair poster board (any color) 36" x 48" (for science fair need by December)

1 three-ring binder with clear front pocket (for science fair, need by December)

Pair of Scissors

Glue Stick

Social Studies:

Pocket folder for returned papers or labeled section in binder (no papers may be stored in books)

College ruled binder paper

Spiral for notes or dedicated section in binder with loose leaf paper

1 composition notebook for 6th grade

Spanish:

1-Subject, spiral notebook, College Ruled with pocket.

Current 6th-7th Grade may use SAME spiral-to continue notes.

7th Grade: Novel: *La Vampirata* by Mira Canion (3rd Trimester) (Paperback-Amazon.com \$6.50)

8th Grade: Novel: *Agentes Secretos y el Mural de Picasso* by Mira Canion (3rd Trimester)
