

Upcoming Events in our Library

The library hosts two Scholastic Book Fairs per year, one in the fall and one in the spring. The purpose of hosting the book fairs is twofold. They are an excellent way for families to purchase affordable books, many of which are on the Accelerated Reader program, for their children in a fun, relaxed atmosphere. Not only do the book fairs encourage our students to read but they also provide much needed operational funds for the library. This year's Fall Book Fair will be held in the school library on Saturday, November 4 – Friday November 10, 2017. Our Spring Book Fair will be held in the school library on Monday, March 5 - Friday, March 9, 2018. In conjunction with our spring book fair, a family reading night for our students will be held in the evening on Friday, March 2nd.

The library is also the location for our annual Catholic Caravans book and gift fair. This is provided for families to purchase Catholic books and gifts in a relaxed atmosphere and provides the library with a small profit for operational funds. Catholic Caravans will be set up in the school library April 17-19, 2018.

The Library is responsible for arranging for our annual Author's Day held during Catholic Schools Week. Each year two different authors visit our school and assemblies are held for grades 1-4 and 5-8. The students have the privilege of learning from the authors about creating, editing, illustrating, and publishing books. This year's Author's Day will be held on Tuesday, January 30, 2018. This year we have authors Rene Colato Lainez and Toni Gallagher visiting our school during Catholic Schools Week. In addition, we often arrange for additional authors and illustrators to come visit with the students at SBS throughout the year. Those events are announced as they are booked.
