

Kindergarten Supply List 2023-2024



These items need to be in a bag with your child's name on the first day of school.

Only label items that say "label"

Supplies Needed:

- One(1) box of 12-count My First Ticonderoga Primary Size #2 **Beginner Pencils**, Yellow with erasers.
- Five(5) boxes of Crayola **Crayons 8-count** (NO jumbo or large size)
- Three(3) box of Crayola Brand **Crayons 24-count**
- Four(4) Boxes of 24 count Crayola **Colored Pencils**
- Four(4) Boxes of 10 count **Crayola "Classic" Color Markers**
- One(1) pair of children's blunt tip safety **Scissors** (preferably Fiskar brand) (**label**)
- One(1) 4ct pack of **Large Elmer's Glue Sticks** (**with purple tint**)
- Four(4) 12ct pack **Small Elmer's Glue Sticks** (**with purple tint**)
- Two(2) bottles of Elmer's white **Bottled Glue**
- Two (2) regular size cans of **Play-Doh** (regular size) (**label**)
- Two(2) **Watercolor Palette** (preferably Prang Brand-8 colors) (**label**)
- One(1) two Inch **Binder** with CLEAR PLASTIC COVER in front to insert a cover sheet labeled with name on the inside and filled with 100 clear plastic **Sheet Protectors** (Binder any color) (**label**)
- One(1) pair of inexpensive **Over the Ear Headphones** make sure it has a volume control/microphone on the cord for communicating on Seesaw (**label**)
- One(1) package of Clorox wipes
- One(1) package of baby wipes
- Two(2) Boxes of Kleenex
- One(1) Box of 1 Gallon Zip Lock bags

Items that are brought to school everyday:

- One(1) **Regular Full SIZE Backpack** with a side mesh pocket to hold a water bottle. (**label**)
- One(1) **Water Bottle** - This should be reusable and should fit in the side pocket of their backpack and should be sent on a daily basis. (**label**)
- One(1) **Lunch Box** for their lunch. (**label**)
- One(1) **Snack bag** for their snack. Lunch and snack should be separate. (**label**)
- Each student **must** have a change of uniform clothes (**including underwear, socks and shoes**) at school. Please **label** with your child's name and place them in a Ziploc bag.
